### INSTRUCTIONS

Supply as much factual information as possible: the precise subject of study, methods used where appropriate, summary of results obtained, conclusion. As it is assumed that original work will be presented, no bibliographic references are necessary.

### REGULATIONS

- Your text will appear in the abstract book exactly as you send it and every error or imperfection will show up.
- Therefore, proofreading is essential, no modification will be possible after submission.
- Your abstract should not contain accents or any other invalid character, which would not be part of the English alphabet.
- Only persons whose registration is complete are able to present their abstract(s).
- The presenting author will receive an e-mail with the Scientific Committee 's decision on the abstract(s) by December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2007.
- **Abstracts can only be submitted in English, electronically via the website: [www.icact.com](http://www.icact.com). Abstracts sent by e-mail, fax or mail will not be accepted.**
- The main author (presenter) confirms that all authors are aware of and agree to the content of the abstract and support the data presented.
- By submitting his abstract, the author gives his permission to the 19<sup>th</sup> ICACT organization to record his presentation during the conference for audio cassettes sales to attendees.
- Your abstract(s), if selected will be chosen for either oral, poster presentation or book publication
- Oral presentations of accepted abstracts will last 10 to 15 minutes, generally followed by a 5 minute discussion.
- Papers accepted for poster presentation will be displayed during poster sessions. Posters will be awarded or encouraged: a special jury will select the three best posters and their authors will receive the SOMPS Poster Award.
